It strengthens our movement and nobody feels alone in the struggle against the forces of the capital and of their political personnel.

Colleagues, in our country the class movement, which is concentrated in the All Workers Militant Front (PAME), gives a serious fight against the anti-social measures which are enforced by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the European Union, the government of PASOK and other political forces which support these measures.
